Centers

Mahatma is always unique in bringing innovation into the classroom to improve the quality of education. In the year 2017, centers for Reading, Story-telling, Mathematics, Science Research, Global Studies, Knowledge and Tamil were established in the Junior school to impart knowledge amongst students in small groups.

Team Teaching

Our teaching instructors work purposefully as a team, to enhance the learning experience of students, through team teaching.

Flipped Classroom

Knowledge, skills and behavior emends with the flipped classroom curriculum and our school takes up this pedagogical technique to create a dynamic learning environment for students.

No Bag Day

The most awaited day of the week is the "No Bag Day" where students come to school happily without their school bags. Learning happens through hands-on activities, projects and research works. It is the most beloved day of the week for students.

MOCK UNO & PARLIAMENT

The Mock UNO & Parliament helps raise awareness among students in world affairs and international relations. Inculcating leadership qualities in students, skills of negotiation, conflict resolution, and cooperation-this session takes place under formal 'Rules of Procedure' to truly model the format of the UN.

International Courses

Looking for a way to break through a plateau, Mahatma schools provide international courses offered by Cambridge University Press, UK. The courses are structured under the Common European Framework of Reference For language (CERF). Currently the students are undergoing the courses from Pre A1 to C1 Advanced for schools and B1 Business according to their levels.

Exchange program

The school has got strong tie ups with the university of lowa, USA.Periodically, a batch of students visit our school and get to know our pedagogical approaches.

ERIC (The Education Research Information Center)

Mahatma through ERIC extends its services to the teachers of other schools. It offers a training program to teachers during weekends. The resource centre also helps government schools with syllabus, module planning and innovative teaching strategies.

OLYMPIAD

Students take up the Olympiad exams every year based on their interests. Olympiad exams will be conducted for different subjects like Math, Science, English, etc which will be conducted every year from grade 1 to grade 12.

CAMBRIDGE AND ISA

The International School Award (ISA), organized by the British Council is a project in which the participating schools work for the entire academic year to uplift their curriculum to international standards. Mahatma is an ISA certified school and once in three years the school works to renew the award.

ORGANIC FARMING

Inorder to promote healthy lifestyle among the entire community, the school practices organic farming and takes strenuous efforts in promoting the message to the society. In Mahatma Alagarkoil campus, about 15 acres of land is set aside for farming and for the past 15 years, a variety of plants are grown using only organic practices. Students are taken on regular field trips to the farms where they get to know about organic farming. Regular workshops are conducted for students and parents where the art of terrace cultivation, kitchen garden, preparation of manure and pesticides are taught by experts.

Non Academic Activities INTER-RELIGIOUS PRAYER AND ASSEMBLIES

Mahatma ever since its inception in 1983 has been unique in many of its practices. The school prayer song stands testimony to this fact. The prayers picked from different Faiths along with Raghupathi Raghav the favourite song of Gandhiji are evidences to show that the school accepts and welcomes students from all beliefs.

Extra curricular Activities

Life on Campus

Medical care

Dr Ganesh Kumar, attends the children every single day. In addition the school also organizes regular health check ups and maintains detailed records of the medical history of each student. Appropriate medical care is provided as and when required. Two nurses in residential and school and a nurse in the campus during school hours.

Food services

School meals are carefully supervised by an experienced cook and staff members and efforts are made to provide a well balanced diet with a variety of foods. Day food is prepared in keeping a view on the nutritional value and other necessary factors. Our school has a kitchen garden. Students do gardening to grow what they eat. School lunch for day scholars is being provided on parental request (either on day or monthly basis)

Student residence

The school provides separate residential facilities for boys and girls. They are managed and run by a caring and efficient matron / warden in - charge. Our school hostels have all the facilities that help the children live and grow in an environment that they can identify as their home. Trained staff members, along with a whole range of support staff, are entrusted with the well being of the children and to ensure that their needs are fully met. The school places much emphasis on the importance of students taking responsibility for themselves, and for each other, within a carefully supervised framework.

Counseling Sessions

Individual counseling and group counseling are done consistently by trained professional counselors, to help students navigate through difficult situations and provide intervention when students face behavioral, physical, or mental health challenges.

Learning Resources Library

A library is a school

Mahatma school was started with a library stocked with books bulging from its racks. We have innovative library engagements for its pupils that can entice a nonreader into the luxurious world of reading and books. We have the story on wheels, telling stories from famous tales by going around the town in the school van. It thrilled children and after that, the reading curve spiked up.

Muyarchi

Education to all is a mission statement at Mahatma. Students facing challenges with reading and writing are identified and trained under the program called Muyarchi. Exclusive training sessions are given to students to amplify their reading and writing level.

NIOS

The CBSE also mandates special education. Children who seem to be having learning difficulties in class are referred to the school counsellor. Remedial classes are conducted for those children separately by the special education teacher. Exam paper sets for such children are done taking into consideration the adaptations and modifications required for such a child.

VIDHYA VAHINI

Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Vahini (SSSVV) program was launched on 23rd Nov, 2010 by Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba to meet this growing demand of making holistic education accessible for all. The program was initiated in our school on 1st August 2014. Our teachers who volunteered contributed in creating lesson plans and multimedia contents for it. Within a year, we became the mentor school for many nearby rural Sai schools. We had the privilege of conducting "Educators meet" - a 3 day learning program for all south Sai schools in India. Currently, we are sharing the modules that we create for our CBSE and state syllabus schools. The Vidhya Vahini team is mapping it to the respective assets and taking it across to rural schools in India.
